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Enclosed please find the full copy of a New Jersey vital record from the period **May 1848 to May 1878**. During this early period, state law required that each municipality file a return of the births, marriages and deaths that occurred in that municipality during the preceding year. The returns received by the State were then bound into ledger-sized volumes. Each page, therefore, includes numerous single-line entries. We have highlighted the entry that best matches your request; this constitutes a full vital record for the **May 1848 – May 1878** period.

*Individual certificates of birth, marriage and death were not issued by the State until  
June 1, 1878.*
